Greetings.

In 2016 I stated to my family that I would become more public with my effort to reconcile with my family and others using **Galatians 2:14** "*in the presence of all*" as my reference. In 2017 that did occur and over time you can see it expanded and matured. Several offers were made and questions asked that went unanswered. Direct questions to Render Caines and Chris Bitterman were not responded to by either of them or the leadership of their institutions. My assumption is **1 Peter 3:15** has been scratched out of their Bibles, or they have no hope.

To my joy Jim Cross offers an occasional email, however has remained unwilling to get on the phone with me. He has offered a few hints from Scripture and indirectly the Talmud, but has not been willing to address challenges, especially on the latter book as it was a great concern. It would be my joy to reconcile with all three of these gentlemen.

As my effort expanded from a handful of emails to hundreds, it appears I hit a nerve. The resounding of Martin Luther and his hammer on Oct 31, 1517 was echoed again 500 years to the day as that morning I got a visit from the Cleveland Police Department stating that someone representing Meadowview Presbyterian Church wants me to stop. **1Co6** appears to have also been scratched out in some Bibles. Intimidation from one or more who refuse to identify themselves will not work. Perhaps the term "coward" applies, since clearly "love" does not. However, my response will be unreserved, open, frank, unambiguous, courageous, and bold (parrhēsia, as in Eph 6:19), and as much as I can, with love in pursuit of reconciliation.

You might note that the website, <u>http://Family.Kozlowski.org</u>, is continuing to grow and mature. As the Lord allows, 2018 will see this continue with vigor. My desire is to end 2018 in celebration with one or more of these gentlemen in a reconciled relationship.

Even though state decree prevents my wife from barring access to my kids, I have not been able to speak with them in over a year. My calls go only to voicemail and I was informed they were deleted. I started sending an email after each call and simply daily added to the same email. It is now 37 pages long. The voicemails have been recorded since April 24, 2017 and are all online with the emails (<u>http://family.kozlowski.org/Voicemail</u>). I want to speak with my kids. I will not turn to the state to do so as **1Co6** is something I will heed.

I have also been concerned what my kids will think in years to come about why their dad was not in their lives. The family site is to show them that I tried to be a part. There is now a specific section for my kids where copies of emails that I send to them asking for them to individually respond (<u>http://family.kozlowski.org/Kids</u>). I am upfront in stating that part of the reason for this is to demonstrate that both the law of the Lord and the law of the state is not practiced by those preventing reconciliation. If you review any of the videos I think you will find they hit very serious subjects. Does anyone have the willingness to challenge me on any claim?

I have also sent USB drives and DVDs to my kids to make sure they will have a copy of all that is on the site in years to come. If anyone wants a copy to archive for that purpose, let me know.

I often state that I'm not playing at this. This is because I'M NOT PLAYING AT THIS. As the Lord allows I will pursue this until reconciliation or my last breath.

This effort has resulted in many things. One of the highlights was a comment from someone who was encouraged to love their wife and I love Dorothy-Jane. Let it be known: I love Dorothy-Jane Kozlowski! I have put out a lot of effort to make that clear.

The primary goal of this effort is to reconcile my family, extended family, and members of the institutional church. I repeatedly state that this is not a battle to win a war or destroy, but a struggle or contention to mutually seek the truth with others and heal. What a joy if my brothers, Jim Cross, Render Caines, and Chris Bitterman would consider joining me in that effort. What a blessing to my wife, my kids, and myself to have a reconciled family. I will not give up until my last breath.
