However, it was a great joy to me some time back to see a brief glimpse of some people rebuilding in Mosel's Old City. Today I saw the photo below from Syria. Rebuilding, even just a little bit, shows the grace of the Lord. I hope you will agree.

Rebuilding in an area with such massive destruction seems futile, but it is the only way to start.

I sent the email below this morning to my friend and brother Chris Prince. He and I literally walk together for many miles. We also look together at the Scripture to find what the Lord is telling us, not what we can make the Lord say. It has been mutual challenges and mutual encouragement. After sending the email this morning, I realized I should also send it to you.

I'm at the table for reconciliation with you. There are hours upon hours of videos online to prove that. The 360-some voicemails over a year and a half should give evidence that I'm not giving up. I have thought often and was reminded again yesterday about Matthew 24:13 *"But the one who endures to the end will be saved."* As a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ, I am commanded to press on, not look back, and endure. This I will do by His grace. I welcome you to join me.

Many things are looking up for me. The raw milk is a big deal. I am moving, and it might be a place that is still in walking distance of where I mostly go, but somewhat out in the country. There may even be things like a fairly large payout on some of the work I have been doing by the end of the year. I am more than willing to give that all up to have a reconciled relationship with you. To be able to talk and share with you as I do with Chris.

Milk is temporary, as is a home and money. All this is trivia, especially from the Lord's perspective. Relationships are not trivia, but the priority. The Lord demonstrated the priority of reconciliation at the cross. Mr. Cross, shall we follow in the Lord's example?
