When we were arriving in the Chattanooga area many years ago mom noticed a sign for Daybreak Suites as a place for us to stay as we made our transition. We stayed over a month. In 2012 it became my home again, but this time alone. I have been here now years and in several rooms. Almost 2 years ago they rebuilt the fourth building and I moved in to a corner room in the hopes it would be very quiet. Due to oddities in the building my room in the largest in the place, but there have been issues. However, overall it has been a great place to be in my circumstances.

The great humor has been that I am in room 420 and while initially I had no idea of the significance of that number, I continue to claim that my room probably has more hemp in it than all the other rooms combined. Some who use hemp in a different way than I do, share in the humor, and there has been noted jealousy.

Because of issues I won't belabor, I put a deposit on a new residence today and expect to start the move tomorrow. In a very real way there is a lot of sadness in the move. In the years here I have developed many relationships, had the opportunity to encourage many, and be blessed by many. I have seen tragedy and death very close, most notably in what was described in the "Naming Names" video (http://family.kozlowski.org/2017-02-25). I am only moving about two miles away, so I'm sure visits will continue. I have also learned in my interactions what is required to practice what I proclaim, and often there is a real cost.

The place I'm moving is remarkably quiet as it is somewhat country-ish while remaining in walking distance of the places I go. My new address is:

You can see from the photo below a good size house with a garage that was built in the 1960s. I has been recently rebuilt and the house was rented just over a week ago. The garage was also rebuilt as an independent 3 bed, 2 bath home, which is where I'm moving into. It is a bit odd to be on a 4.5 acre parcel but be about 5 feet from my neighbor. But again it is quiet. The rooms are small, but it has a great new kitchen. I think I have become a descent chef and make everything from fresh. I have not used a box or can in years and much is from local farms. Consider yourself invited for a meal. I do host others, and family is more than welcome.



I'm letting you all know this because you remain my family and remain invited. I have stated in the past that my home is your home. Nothing has changed except my location.

I'm also letting you know so in case someone again sends the police to my door, you have my new address (http://family.kozlowski.org/2017-11-19+1). While I have been very busy over the last couple of months, as I stated previously I am preparing to make that event very public and specific. I do so because I remain a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ and am attempting to obey His command to reconcile. Sending the police to intimidate me will not work. I think my family knows this.

I have had comments about walking the Greenway in boots, and the speed at which I walk, which is now typically above 4MPH, however that might slow as I now have a lot of serious hills to deal with.

On that, let me put a challenge before you, as I have with others. I walk the Greenway here, which is 4.2 miles end to end. It is no longer unusual to do the round trip in under 2 hours and a good time is about 4.5MPH. Do you think you can beat this 62-year-old?
