I saw in interesting video “**Where Eyes Wide Shut Meets Social Credit Scores**” (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=b7lkj_vbqoo) that I recommend you watch. It uses a very different way to explain things, so I hope you can see what is being said.

Being a flawed man I still considered things like Exodus 20:13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and Leviticus 19:18 something to strive for, irrespective of the cost. It has been costly and my mistakes have been huge, but the Lord’s grace has been marvelous! Where are your priorities?

In the same vein James Corbett is doing a series on the 9/11 Whistleblowers (<https://www.corbettreport.com/911whistleblowers>). I watched the first and it hits home kind of hard. One point hasn’t been made yet that is typical for whistleblowers in other areas, which is of abandonment. Let me also point out that while 9/11 is a rather big deal, it is a footnote compared to what is happening via the cellphone you probably have near you.

One last thing, I had over 3 hours of dialog today on an intense look at Hebrews 10:24-25:

*And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, **not neglecting to meet together**, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.*

While there is the low hanging fruit, like why don’t you meet at a synagogue, as that is the word used in the Greek, our dialog went into depth all around the Scripture and showed the marvelousness of the Lord. I so desire to share conversations like this with my family.

And yet one more thing: I met my friend Mike Day in amazing timing while walking the Greenway and agreed to take him to the hospital Monday for a biopsy. When I look at Mike Day I wonder about Jim Cross.
