George,

Yes, it is me again and this time the video is 15 minutes. The attached version is highly compress so it doesn't look so good but is usable. You can access a nicer version online, but then you might see all the other evidence that I have been trying to reconcile the family for years. You might find out that I love you, your siblings, and your mom. But be of good cheer that it will probably be kept from you.

Those around you who trust in the institution will find excuses or run from what is expressed in the video. To do otherwise is too costly. I mention *"take his cross and follow me"*. Please consider reading where that comes from in Matthew 10:34-39.

I often describe myself as living a life like Fritz Erbe but with a nicer hole. Check into him. His persecutor was the protestant church.

To my joy I might be hiking with a friend tomorrow, so maybe this will be the third and final of this series. But then again, maybe not as you remain my son and since your email, I so very much want to talk with you.

Today I plan on enjoying some wonderful wild caught salmon that I have been saving for a good day. I did a video for you, so it is a good day. I will eat it alone, but it would delight in sharing a meal with you. Perhaps more than one? Perhaps we can include your mom?

I did spend almost two hours today reviewing the Scripture with a friend and close brother. He brought up Luke 18:9-14, which I referred to in the video to Jim Cross. We talked about Colossians 4 and noted verse 6. When it states *"so that you may know how you ought to answer each person"*, it should be clear that this can only be done if you know and have a relationship with the person. A man behind a pulpit does not have that kind of relationship. That relationship is found in small groups only and with dialog as we see in the Scripture, not monolog as we see in the institution. We talked about 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 10 especially the end of verse 6 *"when your obedience is complete."* It was a wonderful challenge and it would be great to have you there. Recently we discussed the similarities and differences in Psalm 14 and 53. You should check on those.

Look at the four videos of the last three days. They were all impromptu. When verses were referenced, typically partially, it wasn't from notes. Consider how well they were applied and if they were rightly applied. Do you see an amateur, a new convert, or from someone who is older and has had time to mature in the faith? In other words, do you see the Biblical model of an elder?

Your dad is a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ and that is by the grace of the Lord. Whenever possible I do not use the term "Christian" but rather "follower of the Lord Jesus Christ". You can see that in emails and videos. I do this because being a "Christian" is typically just being a member of a club, but not necessarily a follower of the commands of Christ, notably Deuteronomy 6:5 and Leviticus 19:18. It would be great to share this with you.
