Subject: George: A long attempt to encourage

George, and family,

Over a month ago I got an email from you relayed by your mom, my wife. About 2 hours later a video response was sent to you. My assumption remains that the now 15 responses have been shielded from you and you do not know I ever responded. This is yet another attempt.

I did get two emails from Jim Cross, the first in two years, and he remains unwilling to discuss anything unless it is with his preconditions and the focus is money and not obedience to the Lord. It is what a proud coward would do, not a man who seeks the Lord. He made the following statement in one of the emails:

When George asked his mama to send that message to you, she was reluctant to do so. But, she and I had a long discussion in which I shared my thoughts with her. I told her that this was a plea from a young man to his wayward dad, asking for his dad to repent (do an about face). I suggested that this just might be the communication that the Lord would use to "bring you home." I let her know that I thought that this heartfelt plea from a young believer to an old believer should go out with prayers for it to be absorbed and acted upon. We have definitely been doing that.

I will stand with the statement to my wife, the person who loves you is not your dad, but me. If I am the wayward dad, PROVE IT! Show evidence that you are willing to have challenged. To be brought home to the institutional church is as likely as pigs flying. I'm too busy trying to love people face-to-face, not via a checkbook. I'm not trying to lead a young believer astray, but to point them to the Lord Jesus Christ, rather than the Matthew 23:15 model.

My assumption is that the young believer he is referring to is you. Consider Act 16:31 *'And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.'*" Note that it is the "Lord Jesus" and not the PCA that you are to believe. Consider my statement about a comment said by Chris Bitterman and how he would drive by a drug rehab place in Lexington and my comment is why didn't he go in? That is what I do, I go in. I do live the Acts 20:20 model and not the Matthew 23:4-7 model. That is why I put out the challenge to anyone to discuss "the Bible is true and the institutional church is a fraud." Where is the man of courage and conviction in the PCA that can back his claim to the institution is in obedience to the Lord Jesus Christ? Is it the lack of courage that they do not come forward?

I want to talk with you so I did the next best thing and did another video for you. It got a bit long, so it is not attached, but only online at: <http://kozlowski.org/2019-12-29+1>. Since my assumption is the others have been ignored, I'm assuming this one will be also. (A side note is that the MP4 version is online and the WebM is still processing and I'm going to bed.)

It is a scary video as I attempt to challenge you to **think**, not a good thing for the follower of the institution. I give **references and evidence**, and that must be ignored. It is also an attempt to **encourage you to question if what you believe is true**, or should I say "**test everything**" (1Th 5:21).

You were encourage to be able to take on challenges. One example I again gave was can you rationally and lovingly refute Surah 4:171 from the Quran. To make it easy, here is a link: <https://quran.com/4/171>. This is a fundamental

difference between a Christian and a Muslim. It is easy to gather in your holy huddle and say those people are bad, but it is loving to be able to say with grace why what they believe is wrong. **Can you?** At the same time when they say to you that you are wrong, can you again with grace answer the challenge. Is Jesus Christ Lord, or just someone mentioned periodically on Sunday?

Can you handle the atheist who claims you are dust from the Big Bang? Can you handle the Buddhist, the Hindu, or the Talmudic Jew? Can you handle the person who is Christian in name only? Can you encourage a brother in Christ? **Are they worth your time?**

I spend hours with Mormons to challenge their beliefs because they are worth my time. I am trying to do the same with you. Mormons respond. Will you? Will even you find out that I sent this?

Covenant Presbyterian shows no evidence of following the PCA General Assembly, or the Bible. I am clearly not worth their time.

Meadowview Presbyterian shows no evidence of love, as demonstrated by the "drive by" comment, the "please to not contact me" statement, and the fear of a call to reconcile that is responded by turning to the police to silence me. Obviously it didn't work.

Jim Cross appears to still think Matthew 6:24 ends with "You **can** serve God and money." **It does NOT!**

He thinks that Matthew 19:9 is applicable to our situation. It is NOT since it is specifically addressed to the man, not the woman, and there is no sexual immorality at issue.

He seems to think Matthew 5:24 isn't in the Bible, nor is Mark 10:11-12. But he does trust in the state (Proverbs 19:8 not 1Co6).

Then of course to show his grace he locks the door and tells me to come in. What love!?

You want an example of love and enduring to the end, look at your dad. How many men would simply say they don't want me, therefore I'm gone. I know a lot of them. Your dad continues to strive to reconcile with those with deaf ears, and I will do so until my dying day. I think your mom will verify that, and she is my primary target.

George, I did my 12 mile hike yesterday and still desire to do it with you. Please feel invited. It would give us some time to talk as father and son and as brothers.

I'm also trying to reconcile with my wife. I will heed the Lord's definition of marriage and therefore not do the shameful thing of turning to the state, but continue trying to reconcile with her because I love her intensely. There is a whole lot of effort online to show that.
