My Lady and Family,

I was feeling a bit tired or groggy around noon, so I took another hike. In the previous 2 days I did 14 miles, and another 7 today. From what I can find, a very healthy person in their 20s or 30s can walk some miles at 4MPH. I did most all of the 21 miles at 4.5MPH. What is the point? Twofold. One is that I'm healthy and might be around for some time. The other, perhaps more important, is an indication of stamina. I'm not inclined to give up. I have described myself as an unrepentant walk-oholic, meaning that when I set a course to walk, I finish the course and don't give up. In seeking reconciliation, my course is set, and I am not going to give up. Few will take a quick 7 mile hike and then do 64 jumping jacks. Fewer still will put the effort into reconciliation seen at <http://Family.Kozlowski.org>. Obviously, I am part of that few.

For George, considering the email sent to me in November, he is clearly reaching for his dad. His dad reached back several dozen times. He probably does not know about any of it, does he?

There are at least two of my kids who have rejected the Lord Jesus Christ, or follow a false Christ. It seems that the rest are being prepared to follow. There is at least one person trying to point them to the Lord described in the Bible, but if they see only hate shown to me, why would they see those who claim Christ and don't live in obedience to Christ's command to love as real?

It seems only obvious that George is right in that he should, and his siblings should, see their mom and dad together. His dad is trying for just that, and has been doing so for years. Our thirtieth anniversary is coming close, and I am going to make every effort to at least get one other party to the table in pursuit of reconciliation. The goal, obviously, is reconciliation with my wife.

To my wife and others, it should not take much reading in the Bible to see that we have only one option, which is reconciliation. Please be clear, does the Bible mean anything to you? Do you believe the Lord Jesus Christ is who He claims to be in the Bible? Do you attempt to follow in His ways? Do you know what love is?

While I think she is wrong, I have far more respect for ErikaLeigh who has stated her reasons for rejecting Christ, than those who live in silence. I will continue in pursuit of her, Brent, and Leo, in my attempt to keep my promise.

I have built the physical stamina to casually take a 10 mile hike at 4.5MPH.

I have studied the Scripture to be able to rationally contend for its veracity, and back up propositions like "marriage begins with sex and ends with death" and "the Bible is true and the institutional church is a fraud".

So with good health and the knowledge required, the next step is reconciliation with family, especially my wife.

I have asked Jim Cross to come to the table, but he seems too scared.

Most of my young kids probably do not know I am trying to be with them again.

Perhaps the ultimate goal, should be the first goal. Dorothy-Jane, I love you, I am your husband, and I want you back. Please respond!
