Family,

Can you look at the kids below and see my kids?



While in one sense they look so different from my kids, some of the photos of the young guy has reminded me of George, especially when he shows the wound on his leg he received from a bullet fired from an Apache helicopter while he and his sister were in the van below.



This is the van shot up in the Collateral Murder video. The actual event occurred around when we in Lower Alabama. You might remember the day we went to the range when we had an Apache helicopter fly directly over us less than 50 feet in the air. We were safe, but the kids in the van were not. The crew of the Apache that was in Iraq in 2007 were probably trained there in Alabama.

I wonder about the emotional wounds these kids have from the event that were too close to. Millions have seen the video, but few know of them. Millions know the name of Assange or Manning, but few know McCord, the man who carried these kids to safety, or as I often describe, the only one in the video who showed love.

I wonder about the emotional wounds my kids have from the event of over 8 years ago. What was it like for them to find out that their dad was removed from their lives? Do they know that their dad has been trying for years to reconcile the family?

I remember the first call after the abandonment when I spoke with George and could hear in his voice that he was not pleased with the circumstances.

I remember the tone of the email from George last year as he expressed a desire for our family being whole. Does he know that his dad has been trying for just that? Does he know that barriers have been put up by many, notably Jim Cross, to prevent our reconciliation? What does his siblings know?

A video is attached to express this with some photos. My assumption is that it will be ignored. However, what happens if in years to come someone like George see it? Perhaps they will see that the person that is showing love to them is their dad?

Ethan McCord was told by his peers that his concern for the kids was misplaced. He was told to “get the sand out of his vagina”. Clearly that was meant to belittle him. As he has subsequently stated, many of those peers are now dead by their own hands.

My concern for my kids is not misplaced. Love doesn't come from more money as I fully embrace the direct statement of Jesus in Matthew 6:24, not the pragmatism stated by Jim Cross. Love comes from pointing my kids to the Lord, as seen in Deuteronomy 6, which also has the greatest commandment. Love is seen in dialog, not silence. Love is seen in touch, not distancing yourself. Love never fails.
