Subject: Seven Oaks - It is time to reconcile!

Family,

Welcome to 2021. For much of the world it will probably be much worse than 2020. I wonder about what it will be like for my family. So many will be celebrating the Great Reset not knowing the submission that will be required of them, or not caring. They will celebrate a vaccine that will save them from a disease that the PCR test cannot distinguish from the common cold or any other corona virus. Nor has the virus been specifically isolated to be able to say this is it. It will be yet another cure that is worse than the disease, and probably the largest thing we will see this year and in years to come is a significantly declining birth rate. You can now be thinking am I a stalker? That would be a demeaning mindset. I suggest you should be thinking that this is a man who is seriously preparing himself with information that may be useful in his effort to reconcile his family. Please choose the latter and also work with me.

The birthday cards for a few months ago are still here with me, partly due to discouragement on my part. However, I no longer have to be concerned about if they will be picked up from the post office. The tie I sent to George last year that was returned, will probably be sent to him this year but directly. I wonder if he will see it this time.

As stated many times now, I plan to make a visit to Lexington to see my young kids. There is no intention to visit Seven Oaks or go anywhere near it. For the moment I will suggest an agreed location and method that does not include my wife. Until there is at least a hint of love from her, I don't think I can emotionally take seeing her in person.

My kids have grown up in the aura of a Christian home for the last many years, but not the reality of it. Isaiah 29:13 describes what you are seeing: *"And the Lord said: 'Because this people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men'".* How many will

hear the dreaded words in Matthew 7:23 “*I never knew you*”? You can see this easily as things like Exodus 20:12 are ignored or rationalized away as not applicable in your situation. It is like those who claim that you have to be pragmatic about Matthew 6:24. To be clear, NO YOU DON'T!

2012 was a year of disaster. 2013 a time of mourning. 2014 through 2020 a time of preparation. I'm confident 2021 will see a radical change. Will it be for the better or worse for all of us? I will do my part to try to make it for the better. How about you?

While 2020 did not show any increase in the all-cause death rate, meaning there is no pandemic, 2021 will probably see a huge increase, but not due to a virus. The world economy will probably collapse in a big way and things like starvation and disease due to nutrition and sanitation issues taking their toll. So many will turn to their god the state for salvation. Who will you turn to?

There appears to be 6 people living on Seven Oaks, and only 1 on 18th street. For decades my statement has been: my home is your home; I will never cast you out. That stands today. You remain invited.

My primary goal is reconciliation with my wife, as I love her beyond measure. However, I have many kids. Perhaps at least one will find that there is hope in a relationship with their dad. As long as I have breath, I will remain willing to reconcile. As a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ, I have no other option. Have you noticed that thus far no one in the institutional church will make that kind of statement or show it in deed?
