It is more than interesting that my wife referred to Acts 19. Do you remember Acts 5, especially verse 29?

I am aware that some of my kids either fully reject Christ, or follow a false Christ. The model you have set before you by Jim Cross and my wife is to refuse any challenge from the Bible and cut communications, which is exactly opposite to the verse my wife referred to. I still don't understand why she pointed to a verse she does not live.

However, if any one of you, now or later, wants a relationship with their husband/dad, as long as I have breath, I am willing. You see there is a difference with me. I not only refer to the Bible, I also attempt to live in obedience to it. This is seen in a willingness to engage in dialog, rather than hiding, or turning to the state. I am ready to give an answer for the hope that is within me, because I actually have hope. I don't need the state to protect me.

What you are seeing demonstrated before you by Jim Cross and my wife is described in 1st John 4:20 *"If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen."* Remember, those are God's word's not mine. It is unambiguously hate to close communications with someone trying to reconcile with you and to abandon promises you made for life. The model I am striving to follow is seen in Mathew 5:44 *"But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you"*. My only goal is reconciliation. If and when anyone is interesting in joining me in that, you know how to contact me.

My Lady,

I was about to send you a text message that I will send anyway letting you know that no matter what you do today or what the outcome, my love for you remains, and I will add my pursuit of reconciliation.

My assumption is that you have not read the document I sent to the court, nor watched the video from Friday night. I press on in obedience to Christ and out of love for you.

You referred to Acts 19. Did you really read it?

*⁸And having gone into the synagogue, he was **speaking boldly** for three months, **reasoning** and persuading the things concerning the Kingdom of God, ⁹and when certain were hardened and were disbelieving, speaking evil of The Way before the multitude, having departed from them, he separated the disciples, reasoning every day in the school of a certain Tyrannus. ¹⁰And this happened for two years so that all those dwelling in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks,*

The “*speaking boldly*” is “*parrhēsiāzomai*”, which is the verb form of “*parrhēsia*”, which I have mentioned often and there is plenty of evidence I practice. Clearly, you and your dad don’t. It is still my hope that will change.

Then “*reasoning*” is “*dialegomai*”, which is the verb form of “*dialaleō*”, which is to talk with, reason with, or dialog with. You read it in the Scripture, you see me attempting it, you claim to follow the Lord’s commands, you point to a clear example of obedience to Christ in the Scripture, but you do not live it. Please, Please, Please, consider what you wrote.

When you turn to the state, you are saying no to the Lord (1Co6). The Lord commands you to reconcile with me (1Co7:11) and you say no. When you state a state decree severs what the Lord has defined, you are putting another god before the Lord (Exo 20:3). Galatians 4:16 “*Have I then become your enemy by telling you the truth?*”

Please don’t show our kids a model of a woman who says 1st Peter 3 does not apply to her and give them a model that the Bible is just a quaint book. What you are living is not a model of Titus 2:4. Love them well by showing them an example of you living out love. What you have done for years is not love, but rather described in 1st John 4:20.

The Lord commands me to love you as He loved the church (Eph 5:25). The Lord repeatedly states He will not abandon me. Therefore, I will not abandon you.

No matter your deeds today, my hand of reconciliation is still reaching out to you! I will continue to attempt to teach out kids about the Lord!
